Dear Families

We are delighted to be able to continue our extra-curricular club provision next term with our Sports partnership with Torquay United Community Sports Trust, as well as our musical opportunities thanks to the team at Blossom. We are also very grateful to our parent volunteers who run additional clubs for us and are thrilled to be able to offer a free computing club for Year 5 children in the Spring term.

Our sports clubs with TUCST will continue to be subsidised by our PE grant or school budget but, due to the financial pressures that schools are currently under, we are not able to offer these activities completely free of charge. Like last year, we are charging £20 per term for a lunchtime club and £30 per term for an after-school club, this is still a significantly lower cost than similar events in the community and we know the children very much enjoy attending. We will also offer an opportunity to split the cost over the term if this makes things easier for you. **However, if you have not yet fully paid for any club that your child signed up for previously, we will be unable to give them a place during the Spring term and any deposit paid will be used towards the amount owing.**

We have again teamed up with Torquay United Community Sports Trust who will continue to offer a range of Year group clubs. TUCST run a number of after-school clubs across South Devon, providing children with an added opportunity to engage in physical activity. Throughout the Spring term, they will be offering Football clubs for children in Years 3 & 4 and Years 5 & 6, Multi-sports clubs for children from Yr 1 – yr 6 and lunch clubs for KS2 hockey as well as extra training for the football teams. The team at TUCST have a thorough knowledge of the curriculum requirements in PE and work in partnership with schools to ensure that they deliver lessons that are imaginative, informative and enjoyable.

Calling all budding netball stars!

Whether you're a seasoned player or just starting out, come along to learn new skills, make friends, and have loads of fun on the court. Excitingly, we have been able to extend our offer of musical clubs this year, with the addition of an Orchestra! This is a fun session, open to pupils of any musical ability and includes instruments such as the ukuleles, boom whackers, tambourines and anything else that will make a wonderful noise! Mr Blurton is really looking forward to developing this area at Warberry. Our choirs have combined for this year and will continue to run on a Thursday from 3:00 – 4:00pm. Mr Blurton and Mrs Mortimore are very excited to work together and will ensure all age groups are catered for. Children really gain a love of singing at Choir and we very much enjoy their performances during our Church services and other events throughout the year.

Mr Bone is also continuing his free Yr 5/6 Chess Club on Monday lunchtimes (although the day may need to move around some weeks).

Whether you're a total beginner or a chess champion in the making, this is a great chance to learn new moves, sharpen your thinking, and play friendly matches with your classmates. No need to bring anything, just your curiosity and enthusiasm!

Registration for the TUCST, Netball, Chess, Choir and Orchestra Clubs is available via the “Clubs” tab on the MCAS app. There are limited numbers of places available for these clubs which will be allocated strictly on a first come, first served basis. Please be aware that no priority will be given to children who have previously attended – the clubs are opened up to all children in the relevant year groups each term and spaces are allocated on a first come – first served basis each time.

Once you are in the “Clubs” tab, please click on the required club and then click on “enrol now”. If all of the spaces have been taken, your child will be added to the waiting list and we will let you know if a space becomes available.

If we receive Pupil Premium funding for your child and you feel it may be a real struggle for you to pay for one of the clubs, please speak to Mr Bone on the gate and we will endeavour to help, please note we cannot guarantee this and cases will be considered on an individual basis. If we are not currently receiving Pupil Premium funding for your child and you think you may be eligible under the income related criteria, please complete the form at [Application for free school meals \(torbay.gov.uk\)](https://www.torbay.gov.uk).

All club memberships will be renewed each term so if your child is not successful in the Spring term they may get another chance in the next term. Notice of when the next term’s enrolment opens will be sent nearer the time.

All clubs will run every week throughout the term; in cases of bad weather, the clubs will move to an indoor space and suitable games / training will be provided.

We reserve the right to cancel any of the clubs due to unforeseen circumstances but must make you aware that the payment covers the full term and no refunds will be given should we need to cancel any week.

For the Spring term, clubs will start the week beginning 5th January and will run until the end of term.

Frazoo After School Club is offered to children in Year 4/5/6 from January 2026. Frazoo is an exciting, educational, animal experience with a variety of reptiles and invertebrates. Mrs Hulbert is a fully qualified primary school teacher with 35 years teaching experience.

The club will begin on Tuesday 6th January and run for 5 weeks at a cost of £45. The club will then run for another 5 weeks with brand new animals if children choose to continue. After that there is no more club. The group size is limited to 9 children to reduce stress on the animals and ensure a high-quality experience. Please be aware Mrs Hulbert does have some children who have waited for a space since September so there are less than 9 spaces available for this term. Please email frazie@frazoo.co.uk asap to enquire about availability for a place which will be allocated strictly in order of emails received to ensure fairness

The sessions will include handling the animals, a species information sheet, an in-depth talk and discussion covering a range of topics eg Conservation, Latin names, Habitats, Food Chains, Zoo Ethics and Care of Exotics. However, they will be discouraged from buying/owning exotics. The children will also receive a participation certificate at the end of the course. The children will wash their hands before and after handling the animals and use anti-bacterial hand-gel. The session will take place in a school classroom.

The club will run from 3:00pm-4:00pm in school. Children will be collected from class before the session and they must be collected on time afterwards unless you have booked and paid for After School Club. Payment will be by bacs or cash/cheque and is due by Tuesday 6th January). Details of how to pay will be given once you have secured a place for your child.
