Warberry Clubs Newsletter – Summer Term 2026

We are thrilled to announce another fantastic term of extra-curricular clubs at Warberry! Thanks to our inspirational Sports Partnership with Torquay United Community Sports Trust (TUCST) and the wonderful musical opportunities offered by Blossom, we have an action-packed programme ready for our children. We are also incredibly grateful to our brilliant parent volunteers who make it possible for us to offer even more exciting activities, including a free Year 2 Gardening Club and a free Year 4 Computing Club this summer.

This term, we are especially delighted to launch our brand-new Forest School Club, led by Mrs Featherstone and Mrs Clarke. This will initially be offered to Year 3 children, with the possibility of inviting other year groups later in the term. Meanwhile, Mrs Panayides will continue her hugely popular Netball Club, where we can't wait to see the children's progress!

TUCST Sports Clubs

Our partnership with TUCST continues to bring a wide range of high-quality sports clubs to Warberry. Although these and some of our other clubs continue to be subsidised using our PE grant or school budget, rising financial pressures mean we are unable to offer them completely free of charge. Prices remain significantly lower than similar community clubs:

- £20 per lunchtime club (per term)
- £30 per after-school club (per term)

We can also offer payment plans to spread costs if needed.

Please note: children with outstanding club payments from previous terms will not be able to enrol for Summer clubs, and any deposit previously paid will be used toward the remaining balance.

This summer TUCST will offer:

- Football Clubs (Years 2–4 and Years 5–6)
- Multi-Sports Clubs (Years 1–6)
- KS2 Tennis Lunch Club
- Girls' Football Lunch Club
- Extra football team training (invitation only)

TUCST coaches work closely with schools to deliver sessions that are imaginative, supportive, and fun—while also building confidence and physical skills.

If a club is full, your child will be added to the waiting list, and we’ll notify you if a space becomes available.

If your child receives Pupil Premium funding and paying for a club will be a real challenge, please speak to Mr Bone at the gate. We will do our best to help, although support cannot be guaranteed and will be assessed individually.
