

Summer Term Home Learning Menu - Year 6

Mathematics

- Ratio challenge: Look at some different recipes for a cake/biscuits/muffins; then create your own thinking carefully about the measurements needed and how many it will make...did it work?

English - spelling and writing

- Learn your 10 weekly spellings and include them in a quality sentence in your journal.
- How many words can you spell of the Statutory Spelling list for Year 5 and 6? Highlight the ones you can spell?
- Practise your handwriting through the LetterJoin website

English - reading

- Read at least 4 times a week and record it in your reading journal.
- Write your own story/poem and share it with family.

Art/Music

As an artist, research the art of Giacometti and produce a copy of part of a whole piece of his work in your own style: drawing, statue, online??

As a musician, write a leaving song about leaving Warberry and starting a new adventure. Maybe take a modern song and re-write the words!. Maybe we could use it in our end of year assembly.

History /geography

As a historian, research WW2 and create a fact file/poster/piece of art to show your learning.

As a geographer, look at maps of your local area and then plot a walk using a map. Think about what human and physical features you may find. Can you create your own map of the walk you went on?

Science

Animals including humans: as scientists, investigate the circulatory system or the heart and blood system. Create a PowerPoint/poster/model of your learning. Or you could investigate how exercise is important for the body. You could create a PE lesson for the class that will increase their heart rate and then maybe have a go at teaching it!
