

Spring Term 2025 - Year 2 Curriculum

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on developing the children's addition and subtraction skills as they look at money and length and measure. They will also begin to explore multiplication and division through their problem solving.

Reading

As the children develop their skills in reading and learn all the sounds in the RWI programme, they will be moving from RWI groups into whole class reading where the focus will be on familiarising them with the skills they need to be fluent, confident and independent readers.

English

As authors, the children will be learning how to form sentences and to extend these sentences by using a range of conjunctions (and, so, but, because). They will be learning about different text types and purposes starting this term with writing to inform.

Science

As scientists this term, the children will be learning about the animals including humans and considering all creatures great and small from germs to large mammals.

History

The children will be learning about the Great Fire of London. They will have the opportunity to consider the causes of the fire, the lack of equipment to support the people of London with fighting the fire and the impact that the fire had on the people of London and the equipment design for fighting fires.

Art

As artists, the children will be exploring the artwork of Eric Carle and experimenting with paint and collage to create specific effects.

RE

As global citizens, the children will be exploring Christianity. They will learn about how Christians perceive God and how the Bible helps to shape Christians' views on God and Jesus.

Computing

The children will be learning about programming technology to make it behave in a certain way. The children will spend time looking at positional language as they programme BeeBots to move in a specific way to reach an end goal.

RHE

We will be focusing on belonging and being a part of the community. The children will consider the different communities that they belong to and how each one makes them feel. They will also consider how they can show respect to people who are part of communities other than their own.

French

The children will be learning the names of the different vegetables in French. They will learn the most common vegetables and slowly build up to learning the names of fifteen different vegetables.

PE

During PE, the children will be learning the skills needed to be successful in gymnastics and dance. The children will learn how to ensure they warm up properly and how to keep themselves safe when using different equipment alongside dance/gymnastics moves.
