Mathematics

- Please login to Times Table Rockstars and spend 5 minutes a day practising your 10x, 5x and 2x tables (the children's Times Tables Rockstars account has the same login details as their Numbots account)

English - spelling and writing

- Watch your RWI video or learn your weekly spellings for a test on Friday.
- How many words can you spell of the Statutory Spelling list for Year 3 and 4? Highlight the ones you can spell.
- Practise your handwriting.

English - reading

- Read at least 3 times a week and record it in your reading record.
- Share a story with family or friends who don't usually hear you read.

Art / DT / Music

- Create your own artwork inspired by William Morris. Which aspect of nature will you choose to base your piece of art on?
- Can you create your own piece of music? What can you find at home that you could use to do this?

Science

We are learning about animals including humans.

- How many human bones can you list?
- I wonder if you can represent this by creating your own representation of a human skeleton.

- We would like you to complete **all the core activities** above (maths, English and reading).
- Choose a **minimum of 3** topic activities to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting and present them however you wish; PowerPoint, fact file, poster, leaflet, photo, video etc.
