

Summer Term - Year 4 Curriculum

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be learning about decimals, money, time and shape. We will be learning about tenths and hundredths and learning how to divide a 1 and 2 digit number by 10 and 100.

Science

In science, our topic is **Animals including humans**. The children will explain the basic parts of the digestive system in humans using research they have carried out.

RE

As global citizens, we will be studying Christianity in the first half term. We will be looking at the events of Pentecost focussing on the question 'For Christians, when Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?'

RHE

In RHE this term we will cover three topics. 'Belonging to our Community,' then we will be looking at keeping ourselves safe online and finally we will be learning about money and work.

Reading

In whole class reading lessons we will be using our reader's toolkit to help us read and answer questions about the text we are studying. This half term we are focussing on a humorous text called 'So you think you have it bad? Ancient Egypt'

History

As historians, we will study life in **Ancient Egypt** and how it shaped the world today. Our overarching big question will be How did the religion of the Ancient Egyptians shape their legacy?

French

In French in this term, we will be learning about 'En classe' which is objects around our classroom. As usual the children will not only learn the new vocabulary but also how to use it in a sentence and apply their knowledge to a conversation.

English

Our first English unit this term is writing to inform. We will be looking at the text 'Once upon a raindrop' and using our scientific knowledge about the water cycle to write our own 'guided tour' script.

Art

In art, We will be studying a global Artist: **Mika Ninagawa**. She works as a multidisciplinary artist and nature photographer. We will be using her style to capture our own photographs which we will then edit using our computing curriculum.

Computing

In Year 4 in Computing, we are looking at photo editing. We will be looking at why photos are edited and how we can edit our own photos. We will then combine this with our art unit on photography to create an outcome.

PE

In our outdoor PE sessions this term we will be working on the skills needed to play Volleyball and honing our running, jumping, and throwing skills in athletics in readiness for sports day.
