

Spring Term – Year 1/2 Curriculum

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on developing the children's addition and subtraction skills as they look at money and length and measure. They will also begin to explore multiplication and division through their

Reading

As the children develop their skills in reading and learn all the sounds in the RWI programme, they will be moving from RWI groups into whole class reading where the focus will be on familiarising them with the skills they need to be fluent, confident and independent readers.

English

We will be really focusing on handwriting and ensuring all children form their letters correctly. We will be looking at nouns, verbs and adjectives in the sentences we are writing.

Science

As scientists this term, the children will be learning about the animals including humans and considering all creatures great and small from germs to large mammals.

History

The children will be learning about the Great Fire of London. They will have the opportunity to consider the causes of the fire, the lack of equipment to support the people of London with fighting the fire and the impact that the fire had on the people of London and the equipment design for fighting fires.

Art

As artists, the children will be exploring the artwork of Eric Carle and experimenting with paint and collage to create specific effects.

RE

As global citizens, the children will be exploring Islam in the first half term and then looking at Christianity in the second half term.

Computing

The children will be learning about programming technology to make it behave in a certain way. The children will spend time looking at positional language as they programme BeeBots to move in a specific way to reach an end goal.

RHE

We will be focusing on belonging and being a part of the community. The children will consider the different communities that they belong to and how each one makes them feel. They will also consider how they can show respect to people who are part of communities other than their own

PE

During PE, the children will be learning the skills needed to be successful throwing and catching games. They will learn the skills needed to take part in team games.
