

Year 3 Summer Curriculum

Maths

As mathematicians, we are going to be applying our understanding of the four operations and building on our knowledge of mass and capacity, money, time, shape and statistics across the summer term.

Reading

During our Whole Class Reading lessons, we will be exploring different texts which will help us to consider how to respect ourselves and others. We will be decoding them and answering comprehension questions based on them which encourage us as readers to retrieve and infer different information from the text. Similarly, we will then explore and answer questions based on different Greek Myths.

English

As authors, the children will be writing to inform. They will be looking at diaries and non-chronological reports. We are going to be looking at the texts *The Gardener* and *Skeletons and Muscles* and we will use the skills we have learnt in our own independent writing at the end of each sequence.

Science

As scientists, our learning will be based on animals including humans. The children will be learning about the bones in our bodies and our muscles and organs.

Art

As artists, we will be learning about William Morris. The children will be learning about some of the techniques he uses in his art and then they will create their own repeating pattern inspired by nature.

French

As linguists, we are learning how to talk about Ancient Britain.

History

As Historians, we are going to be learning about Francis Drake. The children will have the opportunity to explore what life was like for Francis Drake and make connections between this and the modern day. We will be asking ourselves whether Francis Drake was a pirate or a hero.

Computing

The children will be learning about creating media and desktop publishing.

RHE

In RHE, we are going to be learning about our physical health and mental wellbeing. The children will have the chance to explore how to keep healthy and safe, considering their food, exercise, hygiene, and sun safety.

RE

As global citizens we will be exploring the question, 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' They will look at the story of the life and teachings of Jesus, the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus.

PE

Indoor PE - The children will have the opportunity to develop their volleyball skills.
Outdoor PE - The children will have the opportunity to develop their striking, fielding, running, and jumping skills by participating in cricket and athletics.
