Dear Parents and Guardians,

Y6 Exeter City visit by train - Wednesday 15th July

As part of our School Trust Charter, we are committed to providing the children at Warberry with a range of interesting and exciting experiences beyond the classroom during their time with us. As such we are excited to invite children from Year 6 to enjoy a day trip to the city of Exeter at the end of July.

We will be catching the train from Torquay Train Station at 0950 to Exeter Central, arriving at 1054, where we will be following a trail to investigate Exeter's history. After lunch, we will visit the Royal Albert Memorial Museum where we will explore some of the exhibitions before catching the 1522 train back to Torquay, which is due to arrive back at 1616.

All parents must complete the MS Form to let us know the arrangements for end of day collection; due to the time we arrive back in Torquay. Please complete the form by **10.00am on Monday 4th May**

We will be walking to the station so children will need to arrive at school promptly by 8.30am. Children will need to wear school uniform but may wish to wear smart trainers as we will be covering quite a few miles on foot. Please ensure the children are dressed appropriately for the weather, including a waterproof coat and have applied sun cream prior to attending school! The children will need a water bottle and packed lunch for the day so may wish to bring a small, comfortable rucksack.

We have managed to secure group booking discount therefore the cost of this trip will be **£5.41 per child**. *Please be advised that if we do not collect sufficient contributions, the visit may be unable to take place.* Please ensure payment is made before the trip date. You can make a payment via the Trips tab on MCAS – click to enrol and pay. Please note that we are unable to accept cash.

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child's medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child's class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments.

Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the 'Parental Consents' tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child's participation.
