**Swimming: Year 4 Summer Term 2025**

Dear families,

We are delighted to announce that swimming lessons have been arranged for **Year 4**. Lessons will take place on a Tuesday morning and the entire year group will have ten one-hour sessions. We will be starting on **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2026** and continue until **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.

*Please note that there will NOT be a swimming session on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May or Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2026.*

The children will be grouped according to their swimming ability and non-swimmers will be taught in a group in the shallow end. Each Tuesday we will depart Warberry in 2 stages, one class at 08.45am and the other class approximately half an hour later, to walk to Plainmoor Swimming Pool (Swim Torquay). We will return to Warberry by 11.30am at the latest, so please order lunches as normal.

**Children will need to bring their trunks / costume and towel in a small bag and have a waterproof coat;** please name as many items of your child's clothing as possible as this increases the chance of returning misplaced clothing to the correct child. We would also advise that a swimming cap is worn if you have any concerns about your child's hair getting wet. *Please ensure your child brings their swimming kit to school on these dates as there will be very little time to contact you if they have forgotten their belongings.*

There is no charge to parents for this activity and **all** children will be attending the sessions. Please complete the MS Form advising us of your child's swimming ability, by **3.00pm on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> February**: <https://forms.office.com/e/tiJgNTqR5W>

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child's medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child's class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments. **Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the 'Parental Consents' tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child's participation.**

If you can assist us with walking to and from the venue, we would be incredibly grateful! Please speak to the class teacher at the end of the day to confirm your availability or log your interest on the MS Form.
