As part of our history learning, we have organised a school trip for the Year 3 children to Smeaton's Tower and Plymouth Hoe on 18th June. During the summer term, the children will be learning about Francis Drake, and this visit will help them understand more about his life and links to Plymouth.

We will be departing from Warberry at 8.45am via coach and will be leaving Plymouth to ensure that we are back at school ready for normal collection time at 3.00pm.

All children should be in full school uniform for this trip and will need to bring a small backpack in which to carry their lunch, plus a named water bottle. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat and a sunhat, please also apply sunscreen before your child attends school in the morning.

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, you may order a school packed lunch via the MS Form. Please complete and submit by 3.00pm Friday 27th March <https://forms.office.com/e/HwbGeJbLGR>

To enable the activity to go ahead, we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of **£14.70** which includes the coach travel and entry to Smeaton's Tower. *Please be advised that if do not collect sufficient contributions, the visit may be unable to take place.* Please ensure payment is made before the trip date. You can make a payment via the Trips tab on MCAS – click to enrol and pay. Please note that we are unable to accept cash.

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child's medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child's class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments.

Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the 'Parental Consents' tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child's participation.

If you have any questions or would like to volunteer for this visit, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher at the end of the school day.
