Dear Parents and Guardians,

Year 3 Kents Cavern Visit - Thursday 27th November 2025

As part of our history topic “Stone Age to Iron Age,” we have organised a school trip for the Year 3 children to visit Kents Cavern on Thursday November 27th 2025. The visit will include a tour and educational workshops to get a better understanding of life in the stone age and will also allow the children to see the things they have been learning about at school brought to life.

We will be departing Warberry at 9.00am walking and will be leaving Kents Cavern at 2.00pm to ensure that we are back at school ready for normal collection time.

All children should be in full school uniform for this trip but may wear comfortable, plain trainers as we are walking to and from the venue. They will need to bring a small backpack in which to carry their lunch, plus a named water bottle and a snack. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat as we are unable to guarantee the weather. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals you have the option to order a school packed lunch; please do so via the MS Form by 10.00am on Friday 3rd October

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child's medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child's class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments.

Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the 'Parental Consents' tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child's participation.
