We are conscious of the current cost of living crisis and so are very flexible on costumes and have put together a list below for you to use as a guide. We have a limited number of costumes available in school so please do discuss it with us if you are finding it hard to source a suitable costume.

List: We will sort out this costume - ***please send in black t shirt and trousers***

Doors: We will sort out this costume - ***please send in black t shirt and trousers***

Narrators & Readers: Please send children in their 'best' dresses and smart attire (consider tie or bow tie). We really want them to stand out and feel special!

Angels / Angel Gabriel: White outfits (wings and halos).

Tree: We will sort out this costume - ***please send in brown t shirt and trousers***

Sheep: White outfits (with sheep features if possible).

Stars: Black/gold outfits that sparkle.

Wisemen: Typical nativity costume.

Camels: Brown clothing (we will sort out camel features).

Cesar: Kingly attire with crown.

Mary & Joseph: Mary in blue (we will sort out fabric head covering). Joseph in brown (we will sort out head covering).

Inn Keepers: Typical era-specific attire.

Mr and Mrs Inn Keeper: Same as Inn Keepers.

Shepherds: Typical nativity attire (black/ brown/ grey- tea towel on head).



Donkey: Grey costume.

EYFS and Year 1

Children in Reception and Year 1 will be performing in the nativity as part of the chorus and will play a vital role in supporting the Year 2 actors and actresses.

The children across each year group will all have the same costume.

EYFS - Stars - Gold or Black and sparkly.

Year 1 - Shepherds or Sheep as below:

- Shepherds in black/brown/grey t-shirt and bottoms and a tea-towel for their head.
- Sheep in white top and bottoms or a sheep outfit.
