## Year 6 Bygones School Trip - 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> December 2025

As part of our history topic, we have organised a school trip for the Year 6 children to Bygones Museum in Torquay. Due to the size of the venue the two classes will be visiting on separate dates:

- Oak Class Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2025
- Elder Class Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2025

The children will have a guided tour through the Victorian Street and will be able to explore a range of exhibits from different periods including festive additions!

We will be departing from Warberry at 9.30am via walking and will be leaving Bygones at 1.30pm to ensure that we are back at school ready for normal collection time.

All children should be in full school uniform for this trip and will need to bring a small backpack in which to carry their lunch, snack and named water bottle. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat as we are unable to guarantee the weather. Children may bring a maximum of £5 cash to spend if the gift shop if they wish.

To enable the activity to go ahead, we are asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £7.50. *Please be advised that if do not collect sufficient contributions, the visit may be unable to take place.* Please ensure payment is made <u>before</u> the trip date. You can make a payment via the Trips tab on MCAS – click to enrol and pay. Please note that we are unable to accept cash.

As we prepare for the trip, we kindly ask that you ensure all your contact details and child's medical information is up to date via your MCAS login. This information is crucial and will be referred to if needed during the trip. Please do speak to your child's class teacher before the trip if you have any additional comments.

Additionally, please make sure you have ticked the consent for trips in the 'Parental Consents' tab via your MCAS app. This is essential for your child's participation.
